



EXISTING SCHOOL BUILDINGS

Gently sloping 1:2mm gravel path (max. 1:14 grade) allowing access for all from within school down to gathering circle & creek bed

EXISTING SCHOOL BUILDINGS

Planting to include small native evergreen trees to provide character & definition & increase natural shade. The planting scheme will be predominately Australian native, drought tolerant species arranged in a natural organic layout to strengthen identity & enclosure. No irrigation necessary.

EXISTING HARD SURFACE GAMES AREA

EXISTING MAIN GATE & TIMBER BRIDGE TO REMAIN

New kerb & channel to edge existing hard surface courts & direct all runoff water into creek bed

EXISTING HARD SURFACE COURTS

Play/sculptural element such as indigenous shelter to stimulate imaginary play

Optional circulation route over gentle rock steps to encourage challenge and develop balance and co-ordination

Two boulders at junction point to reflect the origin of the word 'Yackandandah'

Interactive Heritage Sculpture - allowing students to understand the gold mining process through touch.

Entry Point from footpath (level) providing link to local community & focusing on access for all. Brick path to reflect historical material
