## Impetigo (School Sores)

We have had a case of Impetigo (school sores) reported to the school.

**Impetigo** causes sores on the skin, which are usually itchy. The sores may start out as blisters that burst and become weepy, before being covered with a crust. It is highly contagious.

Children are to be excluded from school until appropriate treatment has commenced. Sores on exposed surfaces must be covered with a watertight dressing.
