Bob Haanstra will be in on Wednesday, not Tuesday this week for guitar lessons.



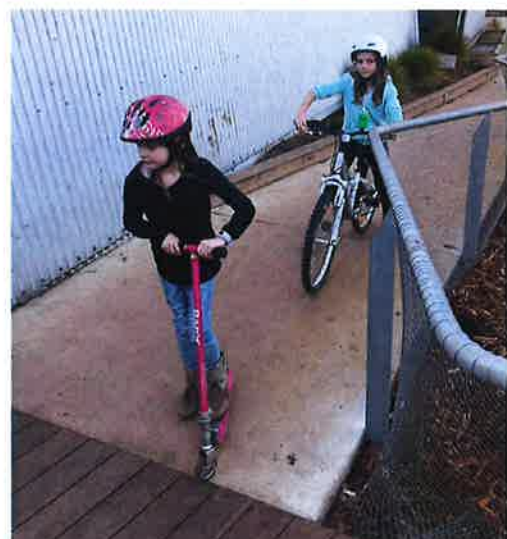
