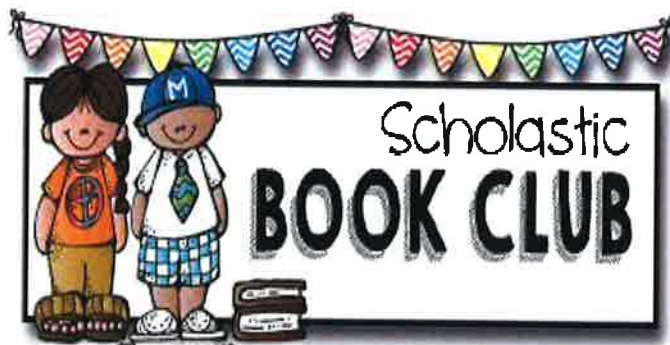
The approximate cost for the 3/4 camp is \$160 and the 5/6 camp is \$390.
